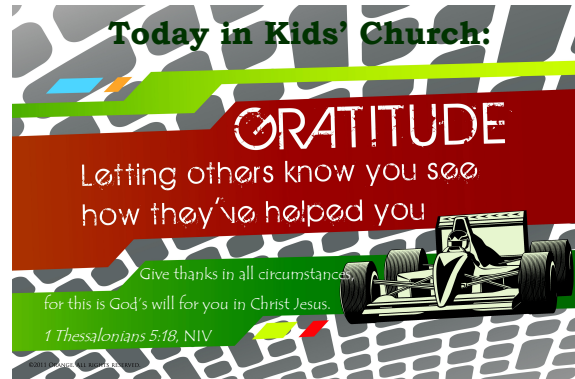
Market Place Items: The children are shopping again with their award coins. When you have "flea market items" to donate, please place them in the box at the Information Center. Thanks.
